

Manager's Report December 12, 2018

All leagues are now into the Third Block of play, and the first session of the Novice League is complete. Marcie has informed me most of the 31 participants have formed teams and will play an 8 game Block for the next session, which begins on January 27th. In addition to the more than 2 dozen returning novices, I have been receiving registrations for the second Novice Session. As well, I have two Learn to Curl Clinics in January to increase the numbers – based on ice availability.

Ice time for School Sessions is fully booked. As a result of Art Kuiper's quadruple bypass surgery, I will take over the instruction, with the help of the Master's League members.

The Mixed Bonspiel was a success – with 18 teams and two sponsors. Because of this, there was an approximate shortfall of \$475.
