Club Manager Update

- A new bar manager and assistant bartender have been hired.
- Current return to curling guidelines will be sent out this week.
 - Tables in the lounge will be assigned
 - Only fully vaccinated members and their fully vaccinated quests are allowed
 - Children under the age of 12 will not be allowed in the lounge; 12 and over are allowed in the lounge provided they are double vaccinated
 - All junior curlers and coaches will be required to wear masks both on and of the ice
- "Try Curling" sessions will be scheduled for October and early in the New Year.
- It was proposed that local artist Gary Nay be retained to paint a 4' x 8' portable mural for our lounge. The expenditure of \$1,000 was APPROVED.
- New lockers will be installed this week. The new lockers are slightly larger and the club's total locker count will also be increased by 20.
- Registration reminders will be sent to past members.
- New scoreboards will be installed shortly.

Other Business

 Junior Curling for ages 9 and up (Peter & Diana) - it was decided that a minimum of 8 participants will be required.
