Tunnel Town History 2021-2022

Board of Directors: The Executive includes Rick Gillis (President), Neil McLennan (Vice-President), David McCulloch (Treasurer) and Clarice Brabbins (Secretary). Club Historian, Bob Fischer. Club Manager, Sandra Boisvert (formerly, McKinnon).

The season commenced under restrictions due to the COVID-19 pandemic, which required protocols and a plan approved by Curl BC. All members were required to have 2 vaccinations, masks to be worn except when on the ice or seated at designated tables in the lounge. Prior to commencement of the game, teams were required to use disinfectant wipes to clean rock handles.

Due to the restrictions, the number of members was down to 309, which also impacted the number of teams entered into our Mixed Bonspiel (12 teams).

New and improved scoreboards were installed in October. These scoreboards were made possible by a \$5,000 donation from Dale Larock and the skills of Larry Prest, who made the frames.

New revised Public Health Orders were issued in late December and, as a result, the lounge was not able to operate for most of January and both the Men's and the Fireman's Bonspiels had to be cancelled. The Ladies Bonspiel, scheduled for February, was also cancelled.

Restrictions were relaxed in late January and again in mid February. The lounge was able to fully re-open on January 27, 2022. Masks were no longer required, and the 4 person square tables in the lounge were replaced with our 8 person round tables.

A team from the Wednesday Night Open League scored an eight-ender on February 16, 2022. The team consisted of Ron Lainchbury, Mike Russell and Arnold Peters.

The Club was able to host an Open Doubles Bonspiel on March 19 & 20, 2022.
